

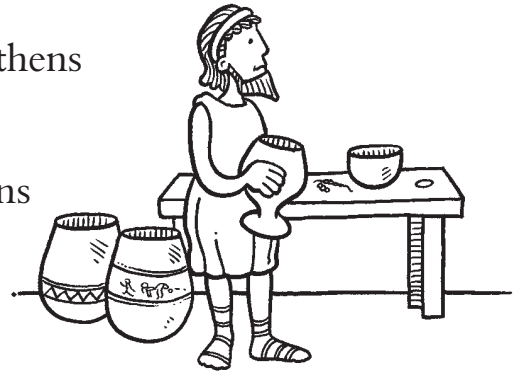
## Not everyone in Athens was a citizen

### Metics

- free men who were born outside Athens
- free men whose parents were not citizens of Athens

#### What rights did they have?

- allowed to live, work and earn money in Athens
- had no political rights
- could not vote
- could not speak in a court of law



#### Metics' duties

- to pay tax
- might have to fight for Athens in wartime

### Women

#### What rights did they have?

- same social class as their nearest male relative or husband
- had no political rights
- could not own land or earn money
- could not vote or speak in a court of law



#### Women's duties

- married women had to obey their husbands and run the home

### Slaves

#### What rights did they have?

- had no legal rights
- some masters allowed their slaves to work and earn money to buy their freedom
- a freed slave could never be a citizen

#### Slaves' duties

- had to work hard and obey their masters
