

Group A

You can play the game. Your aim is to help your team to win the game. You have the power to make the rules. You can also change the rules at any time. (You will need to call a break and tell your team members and the umpire your new decision.) You are able to decide about scoring a goal, where the out of bounds areas are, and if someone has broken the rules.

Your team will consist of A players plus some players from the C group and the D group. These players are there to help you win. C players will help you play the game but cannot score goals. D players can only play when you tell them to play, they cannot score goals. You must tell them how to play. You can decide to tell them some of your rules, or none of your rules.

Group B

You can play the game. Your aim is to help your team to win the game. You do not know the rules unless another player tells them to you, or you work them out. The umpire will decide who is playing fairly. You cannot influence the umpire.

Your team will consist of B players plus some players from the C group and the D group. These players are there to help you win. C players will help you play the game but cannot score goals. D players can only play when you tell them to play, they cannot score goals. You must tell them how to play.

Group C

You can play in the game, but you do not know the rules (unless someone tells you them). You are there to help the players on your team to win, but you can only assist in the game. You cannot score goals.

Group D

You can play in the game when you are asked to help. You do not know the rules unless someone tells you them. You are there to help your team win, but you can only play when someone tells you what to do. You can only pass the ball to someone else on your team when they tell you to. You cannot score goals.
